- 4. Reviewing Themes – Refine and ensure themes accurately reflect the dataset.
- 5. Defining and Naming Themes – Clearly articulate what each theme represents and its boundaries.
- 6. Producing the Report – Integrate themes with quotes, analysis, and relevant literature.

### Coding Example

Sample Transcript Excerpt: 'I feel more productive at home, but I struggle to disconnect from work in the evenings.' Possible Codes: • Increased productivity • Difficulty disconnecting • Blurred work-life boundaries Theme Development: Codes such as 'Difficulty disconnecting' and 'Blurred work-life boundaries' may combine into the theme: 'Boundary Erosion in Remote Work Contexts'

### Quality Checklist for Rigorous Qualitative Analysis

- Ensure alignment between research question and themes.
- Maintain a clear audit trail of coding decisions.
- Use multiple supporting quotes per theme.
- Avoid overlapping themes.
- Reflect on researcher bias and positionality.
